

## 24. Surely He hath borne our griefs (Chorus)

Chorus with Organ

**Largo e staccato**

Organ introduction for the first system. The music is in C major with three flats (B-flat, E-flat, A-flat) and common time. It features a grand staff with treble and bass clefs.
